#### **Additional Information**

BE Free Church is an elder-led, inter-generational, EFCA-affiliated church located on the Connecticut Shoreline. While the church dates back to the 1950's, the last four years have been times of transition and change. With the support of an intentional interim pastor since 2023, BE Free has undergone a metamorphosis, emerging as a core of committed congregants with a vision for growth and evangelism of the Shoreline. Typical service size ranges from 100-120, with a mixed worship style including traditional hymns and more contemporary worship, public Scripture reading and prayer, and a combination of expository and topical sermons.

The senior pastor is ultimately accountable to the elder board. The salary range for this position is \$75,000 - \$90,000 plus benefits.
